

 - o POW/MIA




Chaplaincy

- District Chaplain responsibilities
 - o Oversee Post chaplains
 - o Train prospective post chaplains
- Department Chaplain responsibilities
 - o Supervise Post and District chaplains
 - o Invocation & benediction at all state meetings
 - o Minister to all Legionnaires
 - o Orchestrate observances and ceremonies as available during state, district, and post meetings
- Maintain regular communication with National Chaplaincy, and NE Department, District, and Post chaplaincies
