COUNTY GOVERNMENT UPDATE We are underway with County Government Day programs across the state. Many counties have utilized the support for funding of the noon meal by inviting an Army National Guard recruiter to come speak. The Army National Guard continues to offer this option, but with a significant change. The ARNG requires the use of a Credit Card in order to provide the financial support. Please take some time to explore options if your local Post cannot take a VISA. If you have not scheduled your County Government Day, please remember to get your request form in 4 weeks in advance of the event. The ARNG needs that time to process the request as the funding must be pre-approved by their finance department.

EAGLE SCOUT-OF-THE-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST Nominations for the Scout-of-the-Year scholarship program for Eagle Scouts is available upon request from this office. All nomination packages are to be submitted directly to Department Headquarters no later than March 1st. An Eagle Scout in your community may earn a \$2,500 or \$10,000 scholarship from National if selected from among all state winners. The top three finalists in Nebraska will receive a cash award of \$500, \$300 and \$200. Contact the Programs Director, Brent Hagel-Pitt, with questions.

BIDS ACCEPTED FOR BASEBALL & GOLF TOURNAMENTS The team registration fee will increase from \$125 to \$150, but there will no longer be a fee for the mandatory birth cards that each player must have. The Department Athletic Committee will be holding its meeting for selection of the tournament sites for the Area and State Baseball Tournaments during the Mid-Year Conference. Please check the website or call Headquarters for a form for your Post to apply to host a tournament. Be sure to read all the requirements before submitting the application. In order to be considered for a tournament, the bid form **MUST BE RECEIVED** by the Activities Director no later than January 6. The Athletic Committee will participate in the Saturday program of Mid-Year Conference with a section on rules and requirements, to include the announcement of host sites.



Bids for the Host site of the State Golf Tournament will also be reviewed and selected at the Mid-Year meeting. Interested Posts should contact the Programs Director, Brent Hagel-Pitt, for details and bid form.
